Did you know that gasoline is the most common hazardous material?

The reason why is it number one is because of the high daily exposure rate.

As you know, gasoline is highly flammable.

To avoid injuries while handling gasoline do not smoke or use any other ignition source.

Gasoline should only be used in well-ventilated areas and stored in approved containers. Handle carefully to avoid spills.

If you get gasoline on your vehicle, wipe it down immediately with a rag or paper towel and wash your skin with soapy water.

When refilling portable gasoline containers, be sure to ground prior to filling.

What is Hydro Excavation?


